PRETIME: Handwriting activity – “He is not here; He has risen!”

ATTENDANCE: *(Have one student at a time mark their chart while the others complete the pre-time activity.)*

PRAYER: *(Lead the class in prayer or have a child say the prayer)*

DEFINITION: Resurrection – To arise from the dead. *(Show the vocabulary visual.)*

BIBLE STORY: What was the sad event that happened in our lesson last week? *(Jesus was put to death.)* Our lesson this week is one of the happiest stories in the Bible. Jesus is *resurrected!* What does that word mean? *(To arise from the dead.)* We are going to look at some of the events that took place after Jesus’ death. *(Use the flip-chart to illustrate the story.)* I have another story about the way Jesus’ friends learned he was **alive**. *(Use the color storybook entitled, “Jesus Appears to His Followers” to illustrate this story.)* We are to be “spreaders” of the good news, also. It is a special thing to know Jesus is alive and waiting for us in heaven.

SONG: *(Tune – “Old McDonald”)*
