

# **Trial of Jesus**

Section 9 – Lesson 11

Sunday Morning 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Grades

**PRAYER:** *(Ask the children if there are any special things we need to pray for today.  
Lead the class in prayer, or have a child say the prayer)*

**PRETIME:** *The Bread and The Fruit of The Vine Dot-to-Dot Sheet*

**ATTENDENCE:** *(Have one student at a time place a sticker on their chart while the others complete the pre-time activity. This is a good time to practice/recite the memory work – 12 apostles.)*

**DEFINITIONS:** *(Discuss the meaning of the words prior to telling the story.)*  
Today's Word - Betray

**BIBLE STORY:** Use the felt board to tell the story. Tell the story from #147 felt board page.

**SPECIAL NOTE:**

*(Even today the Lord's Supper is a part of a Christian's worship. This is only to be done by people who have been baptized. It is very important that everyone sits still and is quiet, and remembers Jesus while this is taking place.)*

After they left the Upper Room they went out into the Mount of Olives to a place called Gethsemane. He told them to set there while he went over yonder to pray. He took three disciples with him, and while Jesus was praying they fell asleep.

Then, the chief priests, and captains of the temple and the elders that wanted to kill Jesus came to get him. For Judas, one of the apostles, had betrayed Him. The people that wanted to kill Jesus gave Judas 30 pieces of silver to tell them where Jesus would be so that they could take hold of Him.

So they put Jesus before the rulers and the people, and they decided to kill Him, because they feared Him and His great power. They said that He had broken the law, but He had not. Judas felt so bad after he had betrayed Jesus, he went out and killed himself.

Next week we will find out the rest of the story of Jesus.

**QUESTIONS:**

1. What was the name of the special holiday that was taking place in our story today?
2. Where did Jesus and the twelve go to eat the Lord's Supper?
3. What were the things used for the Lord's Supper?
4. What did Jesus do before He gave the bread and the fruit of the vine (grape juice) to the apostles?
5. What did they do after they eat the Lord's Supper?
6. Where did they go after that? Ask for the specific name of the place.
7. What did the three disciples do while Jesus was praying?
8. Who was the one who betrayed Jesus and told where He could be found?
9. How much was he paid for doing this?
10. Who came to take Jesus away for breaking the law?
11. Had Jesus really broken the law?
12. What did Judas do to himself when he realized what he had done?

**SONG:** *John 15:13*

**ACTIVITY:** Color picture of Jesus & the twelve at the Last Supper. Talk about what each item represents. Tell the children again why we remember Jesus in this way.

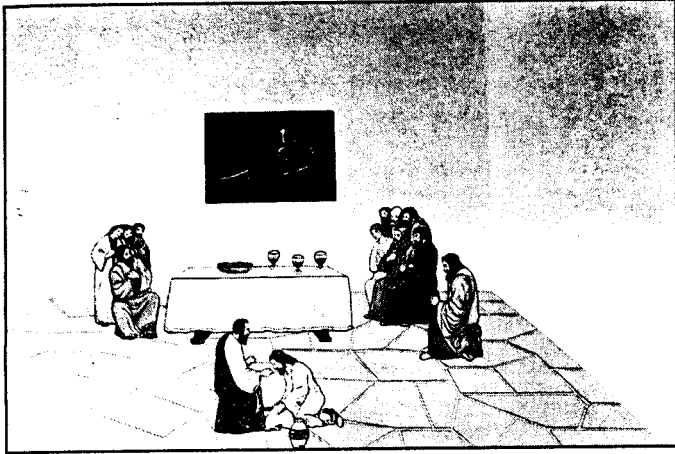
# Remembering Jesus, the Last Supper

Jesus and His disciples were going to Jerusalem for the Passover Feast. They needed some place to eat the Passover supper.

Jesus called two of His disciples. "Go into the city of Jerusalem. There you shall see a man carrying a pitcher of water. Follow him. He will go into a house. Tell the owner of the house to show you a room where I can eat the Passover supper with My disciples. He will show you a large upstairs room. There you can get everything ready for us."

The two disciples obeyed. They found everything just as Jesus said. The owner of the house took the disciples to an upstairs room. In the room was a long table. That night when Jesus and the other disciples came to the room, everything was ready. Nearby was a pitcher of water, a pan, and towels.

The disciples were glad to see the water and towels. Since they wore sandals, their feet were dusty from the long walk and needed to be washed. Who would wash their feet? This was to be a special supper and there should be a servant to wash their feet. Had the two disciples forgotten to find someone?

The disciples looked at each other. Should one of them wash the other's feet? Should one of them do the work of a servant? How wonderful it would have been if one of them had said, "Jesus, let me wash yours and everybody's feet." But no one offered to help. They were too proud. They wanted to feel important.

Jesus knew what His disciples were thinking. He was sad that Satan had put wrong thoughts in their hearts. Since there was no one to wash their feet, everyone sat

down to eat supper. Then Jesus did something that surprised everyone. He stood up and laid His robe on a bench. He took the pitcher and poured some water into the pan. Jesus went around and washed all the disciples' feet. He washed Judas' feet even when He knew Judas was going to betray Him. He loved Judas and wanted to save him.

By doing the work of a servant and washing each of the disciples' feet, Jesus was telling them that they should be willing to serve one another. They shouldn't be thinking of themselves and their own importance.

Jesus took some bread and broke it saying, "Take this and eat. It is my body, broken for you. Do this in memory of me."

Then Jesus took the cup and blessed it and said to them, "Drink all of it for this is my blood which is shed for many for the forgiveness of sins.

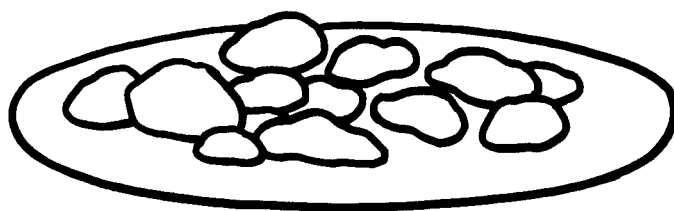
"I will not be with you much longer. So I give you a new commandment. Love one another as I have loved you."

"Where are you going?" the disciples asked.

Jesus replied, "In my Father's house are many mansions. I go to prepare a place for you. I will come again and take you there, so that you can always be with me where I am."

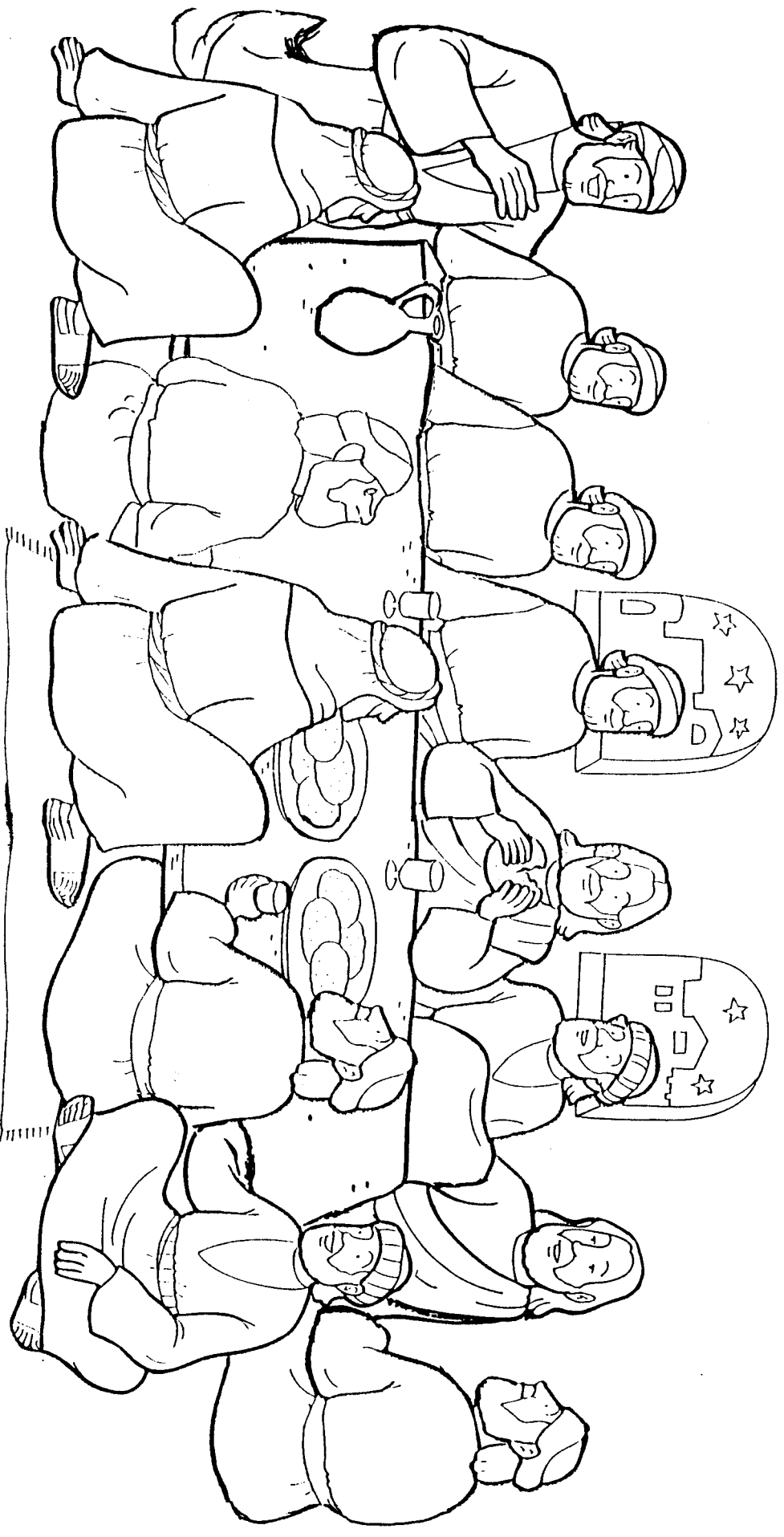
This eating of the bread and drinking of the cup is called the Last Supper. It is a special time to remember that Jesus died for us. A time to remember He is coming again.

After the supper, Jesus and the disciples sang a hymn, and then went out to the Mount of Olives to pray.

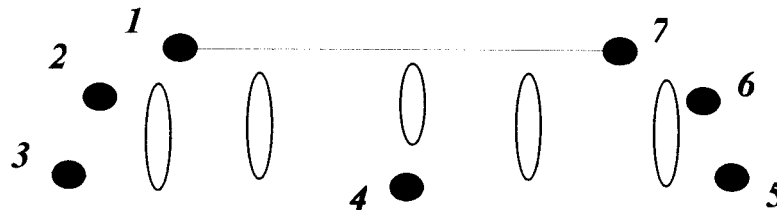

*Jesus eats a special meal with His friends.*



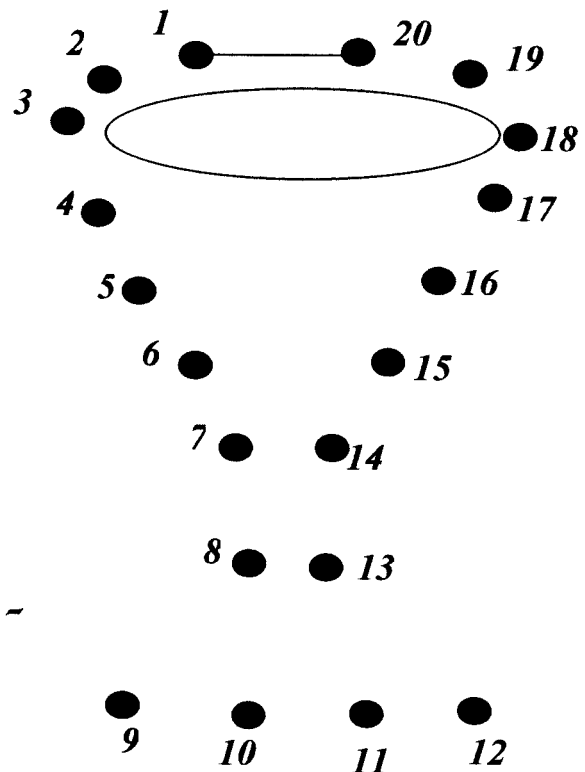
# One Bread, One Body
