Jesus' Transfiguration

Section 9 – Lesson 5

Sunday Morning
1st & 2nd Grades

PRAYER: *(Ask the children if there are any special things we need to pray for today. Lead the class in prayer, or have a child say the prayer)*

PRETIME: “I believe that Jesus is the Son of God” 1 John 4:15 color page.

ATTENDENCE: *(Have one student at a time place a sticker on their chart while the others complete the pre-time activity. This is a good time to practice/recite the memory verse.)*

DEFINITIONS: *(Discuss the meaning of the words prior to telling the story.)*
Today's Word - TRANSFIGURED.

BIBLE STORY:

Jesus took Peter, James and John up into a high mountain to pray. Peter, James and John fell asleep while Jesus was praying. Jesus was transfigured: his face shone like the brightness of the sun and his clothing became intensely white, as white as light. When the apostles awoke, Moses and Elijah appeared, talking with Jesus. Peter said: “Lord, it is good that we are here. Let us build three tabernacles: one for You, one for Moses, and one for Elijah.” While Peter was speaking, a bright cloud came over them and a voice came out of the cloud, saying: “This is My beloved son, with whom I am well pleased, hear ye Him!” Hearing the voice, the disciples bowed down and were afraid. Jesus came near to them and touched them, saying: “Rise up and do not be afraid.” They lifted up their eyes and saw only Jesus before them.

Tell the children that:

Jesus came to do the Father's will not His own.

He confirms that He is the Son of God.

God has given Him all authority to make judgement.

Believing on His words will give everlasting life.

QUESTIONS:

1. Whom did Jesus take with Him up on the high mountain?
2. Why did they go up there?
3. What did Peter, James and John do while Jesus was praying?
4. When they woke up whom did they see? What did they look like?
5. What did Peter say?
6. What came over them as Peter was speaking?
7. What did the voice from heaven say?
8. Where they afraid when they heard the voice?
9. What did they do?
10. What did Jesus do and say?
11. Jesus came to do the will of whom?
12. Who is the Son of God?
13. Does Jesus have all authority to make judgement?
14. Should we believe on His words? Why?

SONG: "I Love To Tell The Story"
Have the children request the song they want to sing.

ACTIVITY: Color sheet of Jesus' transfiguration.

BIBLE FACT: *(Quiz children as they are completing the activity listed above.)*

- How many parts is the Bible divided into?
- How many books are in the Old Testament?
- How many books are in the New Testament?
- Name the books of the Old Testament.
- Name the books of the New Testament.

(This can be done as a group or, have a child recite the books. Record the "single" child's progress on the "memory-record" poster.)

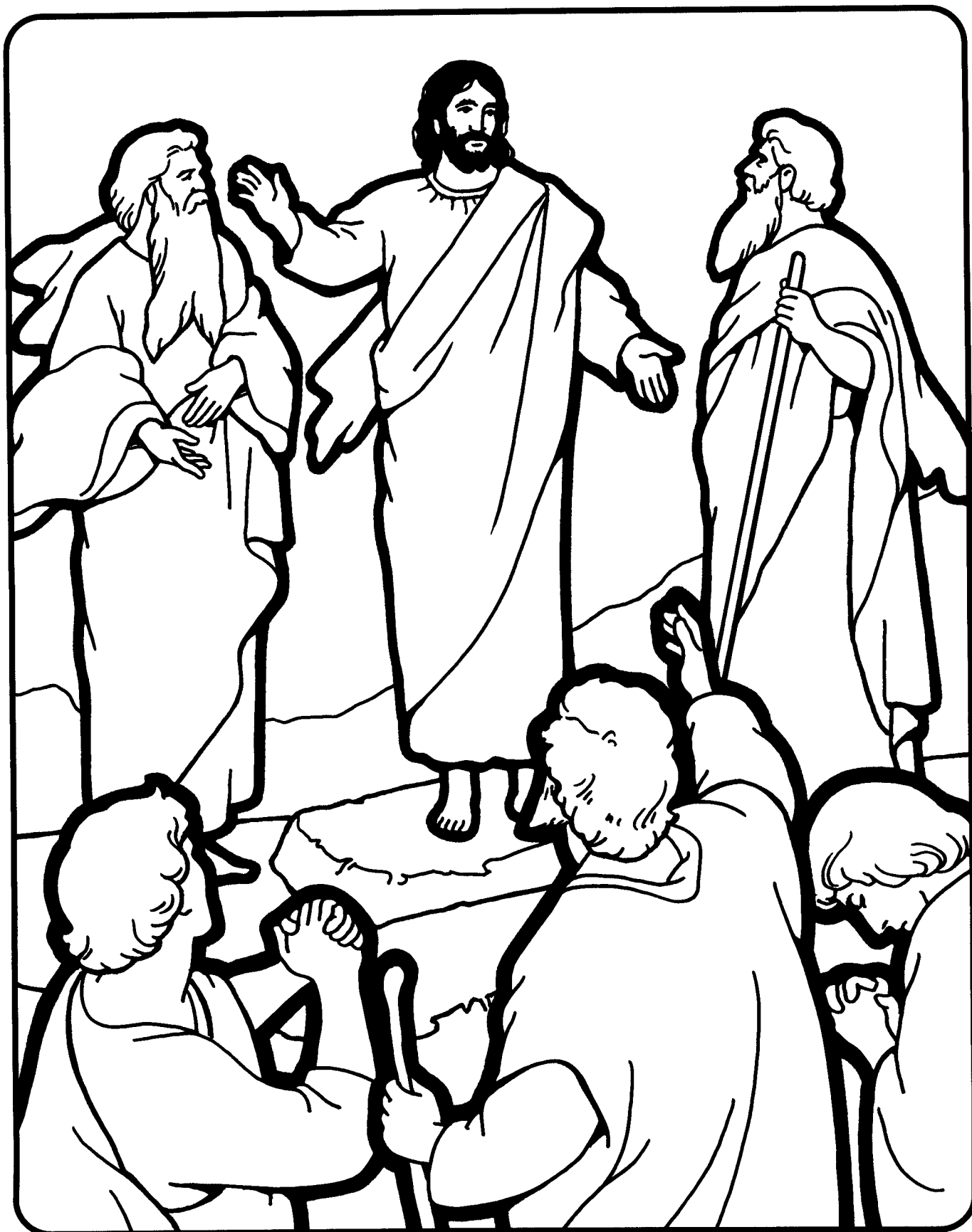
MEMORY WORK:

Concept development - God head - Recognizing Jesus, the Son

Definition

Confess: to admit belief or love for someone
admit to having done something wrong

Transfigure:- to change the outward appearance
Glorified appearance

Lesson

Read Lk. 9:18-20, then vs. 26-36

“It was important that the apostles who were Jews, understand that Jesus was higher/better/more important than Moses and Elijah. When they saw Moses and Elijah in their glorified appearance they wanted to worship all three, but God’s voice from heaven told them , “This is my Son, my chosen one, Listen to Him!”

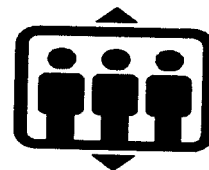
