Concept development: Godhead – Receiving Holy Spirit baptism

Body:

Cornelius was a Centurion in the Roman army
A devout man; One that feared God with his entire house; Gave much alms; Prayed to God always
About the 9th hour, while fasting and praying, an angel appeared unto him
God has remembered your deeds
Send for Peter who will speak words that you may be saved
Peter was on the rooftop to pray and became hungry and fell into a trance
A vessel was let down by the four corners full of unclean animals
A voice said kill and eat
Peter said that he had never eaten anything unclean
What God had cleansed call not common or unclean
While Peter was thinking about this Cornelius' men arrived asking for Peter
The Spirit spoke to Peter and told him to go with them without doubt
The next morning Peter and 6 Jewish Christian with to Cornelius' house
When Peter arrived Cornelius fell down to worship him
As they went into the house Peter saw that he had gathered many people to hear Peter
Peter said that it was not right for a Jew to be in the house of a Gentile
God has shown me that it is no longer the case
I came with out complaint
These things were said for both Cornelius and the 6 Jews
Why did you send for me
Cornelius told all that had taken place
Peter began to preach Jesus of Nazareth to Cornelius and all those gathered in his house
While Peter spoke the Holy Spirit fell on those that heard the Word
Peter commanded that they be baptized
When Peter returned to Jerusalem certain of the Jews contended with him on this matter
When they heard this they glorified God for giving repentance to the Gentiles

Herod Agrippa I (AD 44) began to persecute certain of the church
Killed James the brother of John with a sword
He then put Peter in prison intending on killing him
The saints began to pray earnestly for Peter
The night before Herod was going to kill Peter
He was bound by two chains between two guards in a locked cell
One guard at the cell door and another down the hall at the next entrance
An angel appeared and took Peter out of the prison
Unchained from the two guards
By the two guards outside of the cell and out of the Iron Gate
Peter then went to the house of Mary mother of John Mark
When he knocked on the door Rhoda came to see who was there
She knew his voice but did not let him in for her gladness
The others did not believe her
Peter told them what had happened and then went to another place

That morning the guards could not believe that Peter was gone
When Herod found out he had the guards examined and put to death
Herod went to Caesarea and made a speech and the people said that it was the voice of a god
He took the credit and did not give God the credit
An angel smote Herod with worms and he died (5 days)

Lesson Overview -

 - Holy Spirit falls upon the house of Cornelius.
 - Cornelius' household was baptized.

Acts 11: Peter explains to his fellow Jewish Christians how God has accepted ~~the~~ Gentiles. Cornelius & his household were the first Gentiles to be converted to Christ.

Acts 11:26 - the disciples were first called Christians at Antioch.

Acts 12: Peter is imprisoned by Herod. He is put in maximum security, but an angel of the Lord frees Peter. He appears at the house of ~~Rhoda~~ Mary. A young girl by the name of Rhoda answers the door & is so surprised to see Peter. She shuts the door in his face. Rhoda & others finally see Peter and are astonished at his being out of prison. Peter tells of the angel freeing him from his bonds. Peter leaves to go somewhere else.

Herod ~~Agrippa~~ orders soldiers' death who had kept watch over Peter. ~~Agrippa~~ Herod then goes to Caesarea and gives a speech. The people claim it is the voice of a god. Herod takes credit & God strikes him with worms. Herod dies.
