The Third Journey

Concept development: Church – Recognizing acts of worship, teaching corrects error

Body:

Apollos was a Jew from Alexandria, a learned and eloquent man, mighty in the scriptures, fervent in the spirit
He taught accurately the things of Jesus knowing only the baptism of John
Came to Jerusalem during the feast and heard John and Jesus
Heard from another about John and Jesus
He probably did not know of the death and resurrection of Jesus or of the coming of the Holy Spirit
Aquila and Priscilla took him aside and taught him more accurately
He then went to Corinth and helped the brethren much

Ephesus

Paul found 12 men who only knew the baptism of John and did not know of the Holy Spirit
He taught them and they were baptized and received the Holy Spirit by Paul laying his hands on them
Paul went to the synagogue to boldly proclaim the word for 3 months
Some were hardened and disobedient speaking evil of the way
Paul started to teach daily in the school of Tyrannus
Paul remained there for 2 years and taught all that were in Asia
God gave Paul special powers and miracles
People brought Paul Handkerchiefs and aprons of the sick for Paul to touch
All manner of sickness was healed and evil spirits came out of the people
Jewish exorcists
Commanded the spirits to come out in the name of Jesus that Paul preached
We know Jesus and Paul but who are you and they jumped on them
Fear came upon all and the name of the Lord was magnified
Many Christians came confessing and declaring their deeds
Burned their books of magic and stopped practicing it
Demetrius the silversmith caused a great uprising
The preaching of the gospel was cutting into his profits
The mob rushed through town and took Gaius and Aristarchus
The mob cried "Great is the Diana of the Ephesians" for two hours
The town clerk quieted the crowd and told them they need not do this and dismissed them

Troas

Paul stayed there 7 days and preached unto them on the first day of the week
He continued long and preached until midnight
Eutychus fell asleep and fell out of the window and died
Paul went down and raised him from the dead
They ate and talked then Paul left at day break

Miletus

He sent for the elders of Ephesus
Paul warned them to
Feed the flock
Grievous wolves will enter into the flock
Some of the elders would preach false doctrine and draw men away
Paul encouraged them to follow God's word that He had preached unto them

Tyre

They asked Paul to not go to Jerusalem (By the spirit)
The whole congregation came out to see Paul depart

Caesarea

Paul came into the house of Phillip the evangelist (one of the seven in ch. 6)
He had four daughters that prophesied
Agabus a prophet from Judea took Paul's girdle and bound himself
They all pleaded with Paul not to go to Jerusalem
