Peter and John Imprisoned

Concept development: Church – Confirming the Word, Spreading the Gospel boldly

Words to define: alms; in the name of

Body:

The Miracle

Peter and John going to the temple to pray and teach
A man that was lame from his birth {40 + years old} was laid at the door called Beautiful begging alms
The man called to Peter and John asking to receive alms of them
Peter and John gave the man their full attention and Peter said, "Look on us"
Peter wanted the lame man's full attention
Peter wanted the attention of those around him
Peter said that he did not have silver and gold but would give the man what he had
Peter commanded the man to arise and walk in the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth
Peter took him by his right hand and raised him up
The man stood and began to walk and leap and praising God
The crowd gathered around greatly wondering what had happened

The Sermon

The God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob did this, through His servant Jesus
Whom ye delivered to Pilate to be crucified
Denied His release to let a murderer go free
Ye have killed the Prince of Peace whom God has raised from the dead
Calls them to repent and be converted that your sins be blotted out
Moses talks of the prophet that would be like him and all must hear Him
All of the prophets spoke of the coming Christ
In Abraham all of the nations shall be blessed
God having raised up Jesus the Christ
Sent Him to bless you
Turning you away from your iniquities

Imprisoned

As they spoke the priest and Sadducees came upon them
Very upset that they were preaching in Jesus the resurrection from the dead
Peter and John were put in prison
Many believe and the number of the saved came to be about 5,000
The rulers gathered together those that agreed to judge them
They asked by what authority do you do teach these things?
Peter answered being filled with the Holy Spirit
We are examined concerning a good deed
What we do is in the name of Jesus of Nazareth
Ye crucified; God raised Him from the dead
Ye cast Him away but God made Him the chief corner stone [Psalms 118:22]
In no other name is there salvation
The rulers could not deny such a notable miracle
They commanded them to stop preaching in the name of Jesus
Peter and Johns answered that they would obey God rather than man
We have to speak what we have heard and saw
Peter and John returned to their fellow Christians and told them all that happened
They all lifted up their voices to God
David said that all would be against God's anointed
They ask for boldness to teach, signs and wonders
