5. List three main points in Peter's sermon found in verses 22-24. (Acts 2:22-24)
6. Name two ways that Jesus is superior to David? (Acts 2:29-35)
7. What was it that the Jewish people finally understood that caused them to feel so guilty?
(Acts 2:36-37)
8. What did Peter tell them to do? How many did it? (Acts 2:38-41)
9. What did the early Christians do? (Acts 2:42)
