6. What did Saul do that angered the Jews? (Acts 9:19-25)
7. How was Saul accepted by the saints at Jerusalem? (Acts 9:26-30)
8. Describe the state of the church at this time? (Acts 9:31)
9. What miracle did Peter do in Lydda? (Acts 9:32-35)
10. What miracle did Peter do in Joppa? (Acts 9:36-43)
