2. How long did it take the healing to take affect? (Acts 3:7-8)
3. What do you think was the purpose of this miracle? (Acts 3:4,11)
4. Peter was preaching to what kind of people? (Acts 3:1,12)
5. What had these people done that should have made them feel very badly. (Acts 3:13-15)
6. How was the seed promise given to Abraham fulfilled? (Acts 3:24-26)

7. Why did the Sadducees have Peter and John arrested? (Acts 4:1-3)
8. Outline what Peter told the Jewish rulers and elders? (Acts 4:8-12)
9. A miracle was done and Jesus was preached. Contrast the reaction of the Jewish crowd to the reaction of the Jewish rulers? (Acts 4:4, 4:16-18)
10. How did God answer the prayer of the Christians to preach with boldness? (Acts 4:29-31)
