Questions

Chapter 8 tells how the persecution scattered the Christians which actually helped the gospel spread quicker. Simon, a magician, is converted and baptized. He sins by trying to buy the gift of "laying on hands" to impart spiritual gifts. He is told to repent and pray for forgiveness. Philip teaches the Ethiopian eunuch on the chariot. The eunuch is baptized.

2. How did this affect the growth of the church? (Acts 8:4, 9:31)
3. How did Saul treat the church? (Acts 7:58, 8:3)
4. Who first preached Christ in Samaria? (Acts 8:5)
5. What was significant about Simon being amazed at the signs and miracles done by Philip?
(Acts 8:9-11)

6. What had to happen for the baptized people in Samaria to receive the Holy Spirit? (Acts 8:14-17)

7. How did Simon sin and what did he need to do to receive forgiveness? (Acts 8:18-24)

8. Who directed Philip to the eunuch? (Acts 8:26,29)

9. What did Philip preach to the eunuch and what did this cause the eunuch to say? (Acts 8:35-36)

10. What did the eunuch confess? (Acts 8:37)
