Please read Acts 9

1. There are many people in the world today who believe in God, many act "more zealous" than you or I. What does the example of Saul show us about being pleasing to God? Is our zeal and enthusiasm going to determine where we spend eternity? (key scriptures??)
2. Does a clear conscience contribute to, or determine your salvation? (Hint: Did Saul/Paul always serve God w/ a clean conscience? Find it)
3. Granted that God knows all, sees all... but have you even wondered - what about *ME*? Really when its all said and done, does God actually *know* who I am, where I am, and care what is going on in my life? Give a couple of verses along these lines.
4. At what point in the story (what verse) do you see Saul saying or doing something that would lead you to believe that he was sorry for the damage he had done and/or that he was a changed man? When were his sins forgiven? Compare later accounts in Acts 22 and 26 to help you.
5. Describe Saul's reputation. How did his new family receive him? How did his old family (the Jews) receive him?



6. How would you feel in Ananias' position? Describe the most difficult and unlikely person you know to share the gospel with.

7. What part did miracles play in the salvation of the people in this chapter? What was the purpose of miracles that we discussed before?
