Please read: Acts 3-4

1. What sect of the Jews was particularly opposed to what Peter and John taught about Jesus, why? Give an example from later in the book of Acts when Paul uses this to his advantage.
2. Define what is meant by "in the name of..." or "by what name..." (Acts 4)
3. What "miracles" have you heard of happening today? What is the difference between miracles today and those that were performed in the book of Acts?
4. In Acts 4:16 the Council recognizes that a noteworthy miracle took place and that the fact was not debatable. In the Gospels, two other notable miracles occurred; the resurrection of Lazarus and Jesus Himself. What plots were devised to conceal the truth in these cases?
5. Use a concordance to find an instance when Jesus referred to himself as the chief cornerstone and two references in the Old Testament. Also find a couple of references in the New Testament. (Try words like cornerstone, corner stone, head of the corner, and foundation)



6. Find out the significance of a corner stone in the construction of a building during this time. Use Acts 4:11 and the scriptures you found in the previous question to determine how Jesus fits the comparison to a corner stone in the church.
