Please read Acts 18:23-21:16

1. If women are supposed to be quiet and not in authoritative positions how do you explain Priscilla's actions, here and in other passages?
2. What was wrong with John's baptism? (18:25- 19:4)
3. Today people offer different, more convenient, less messy methods of "baptism." What baptism do we read of occurring in the Old Testament? Compare these to John's baptism and to the baptism of the new covenant.
4. Why did the evil spirit in Acts 19 attack the Jews who commanded him to leave "by Jesus who Paul preaches?" Weren't they were doing a good deed, and giving credit to Jesus?
5. Describe the reaction of the Ephesians to the above incident in Acts 19:13+ What was the effect on the gospel in the area?
6. What motivated the riot against Paul and the other Christians in Ephesus? (example: Jewish leaders didn't like his teaching b/c he became more "popular," and lost some of their following)
