1. Describe Peter's vision and the meaning. What did the unclean animals represent?
2. When Peter arrived at Cornelius' house, describe the reception he received and the people present.
3. After reading the chapters, list some qualities you see in Cornelius that all Christians should possess.
4. * Why was the Holy Spirit poured out on the Gentiles (the purpose of Holy Spirit baptism)? Were they saved because of this? What is the purpose of water baptism?
5. Some people believe in infant baptism and cite Acts 10:2, 24, 48 (household, all of his relatives and friends, were there and verse 48 ordered them to be baptized). What passages can you think of that would support this or teach something else?
6. What name should followers of Christ wear? How important are the names we wear to God? Give 3 scriptures to support your answer.
