Galatians - Salvation by gospel not by Moses law

Stand Fast

Concept development: Christianity - Knowing the gospel is for all

Words to define: Servant - NT: 1401- doulos (doo'-los); from NT: 1210; a slave (literal or figurative, involuntary or voluntary; frequently, therefore in a qualified sense of subjection or subserviency): Strong's Concordance

Body: Stand up against - idea of lesson (stand fast to what they knew the gospel was)
 Galica - same area as France

Any false gospel Gal. 1:8-9

Beware of people teaching another gospel

Not another (another way to be saved)

If taught by an apostle or an angel

only one gospel 1:6,7 gospel - different meaning
 gospel - good news - only one, not
 more, people are accepting
 multiple gospels

Being men pleasers

Are we pleasing God or Men?

We are a bondservant to Christ - servant def. (1:10)

Christian - voluntarily being a servant to Christ

Deny Paul's Apostleship

His first visit he was received as an angel [4:13-15]

They would have given Paul their own eyes

They questioned Paul's apostleship

He was chosen and sent by Christ

He was not around the apostles to be sent by them

Paul speaks for about chapter and half on his apostleship

Going back to the Old Law

Did you receive the Spirit by the works of the Law or hearing of Faith

Did you start in the Spirit but now perfected in the flesh

Where are the miracles coming from?

The works of the law

The hearing of faith

Abraham was counted righteous by his faith

Sons of Abraham was not by blood relation but by faith

To be justified by the law it must be followed perfectly

The law failed because of sin

The promise of the land failed because of sin

The main promise was not the land or a great nation but the coming Christ

Not seeds but seed - Jesus

everyone has focus of
 land and nation, but
 focus is Christ

Sons of Faith are true sons of Abraham, not because
 you are Jews

Gal 5:1 "yoke of bondage"

Jews were so caught up in "law of works" so caught
 up in following law, but heart was not in it (Pharisees)
 seen of men
