Concept development: Salvation – Receiving eternal reward

Words to define:

Shout - NT: 2752 - keleusma (kel'-yoos-mah) or keleuma (kel'-yoo-mah); from NT: 2753; a cry of incitement: KJV - shout. NT: 2753 - keleuo (kel-yoo'-o); from a primary kello (to urge on); "hail"; to incite by word, i.e. order: KJV - bid, (at. give) command (-ment). **Call to Lazarus to come from the grave*

Archangel - NT: 743 - archaggelos (ar-khang'-el-os); from NT: 757 and NT: 32; a chief angel: KJV - archangel. NT: 757 - archo (ar'-kho); a primary verb; to be first (in political rank or power): KJV - reign (rule) over.

The day of the Lord will come as a thief in the night

The heavens shall pass away with a great noise and the elements shall be dissolved with fervent heat

The earth and the works therein shall be burned up
