Open your Bible to II Pet 2 (so they see you are teaching from the Bible). Use flannelgraph of one man pointing, group of people standing together listening, one man looking sly(whispering to the group)

Discussion

Tonight we are going to read in the Bible about people that will try to teach us things that are wrong or false. They are false teachers.

The scriptures tell us they try to do things in secret (put up sly fellow) II Pet. 2:1

They even teach us to deny the Lord. Who is our Lord? Who saves us from being punished?

When people listen to the false teachers other people will make fun of God's way (II Pet. 2:2)

False teachers are greedy for money or wanting people to only listen to them and be able to fool people that don't know the truth (II Pet. 2:3)

How does God feel about people that sinned? ANGELS were even thrown down out of heaven when THEY sinned (II Pet. 2:4)

(Show a picture of Noah or ark, etc.) What did God do with the wicked people on the earth in Noah's day? (2:5)

(Show picture of Lot escaping Sodom and Gomorrah) What happened to the cities that were wicked where Lot lived?

One of the Lord's brothers, Jude warned the christians about false teachers. Jude and James were brothers of Jesus. They knew that the way to guard against teachers that want to influence us to do wrong, was to hold on to what Jesus taught.

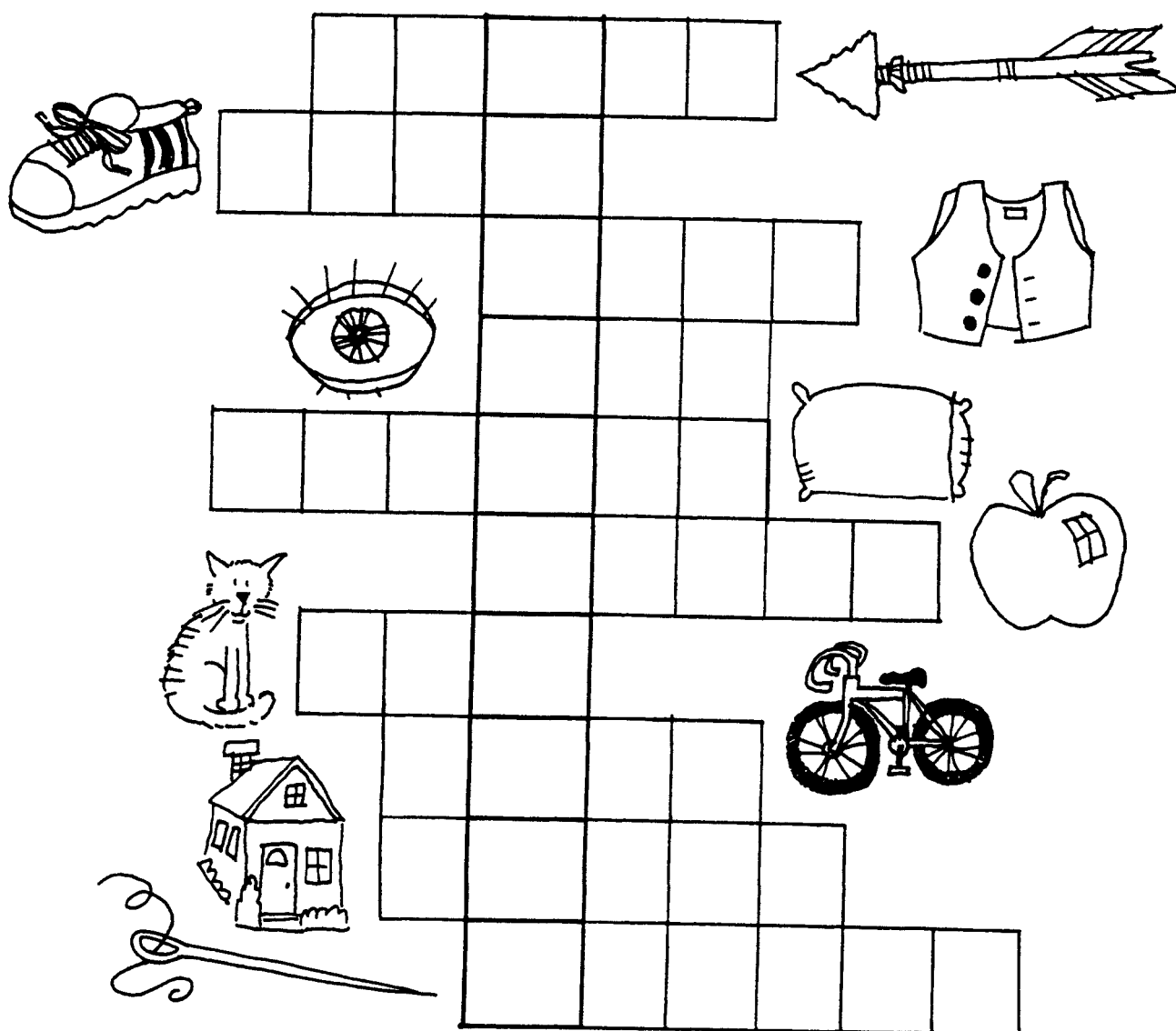
Take home

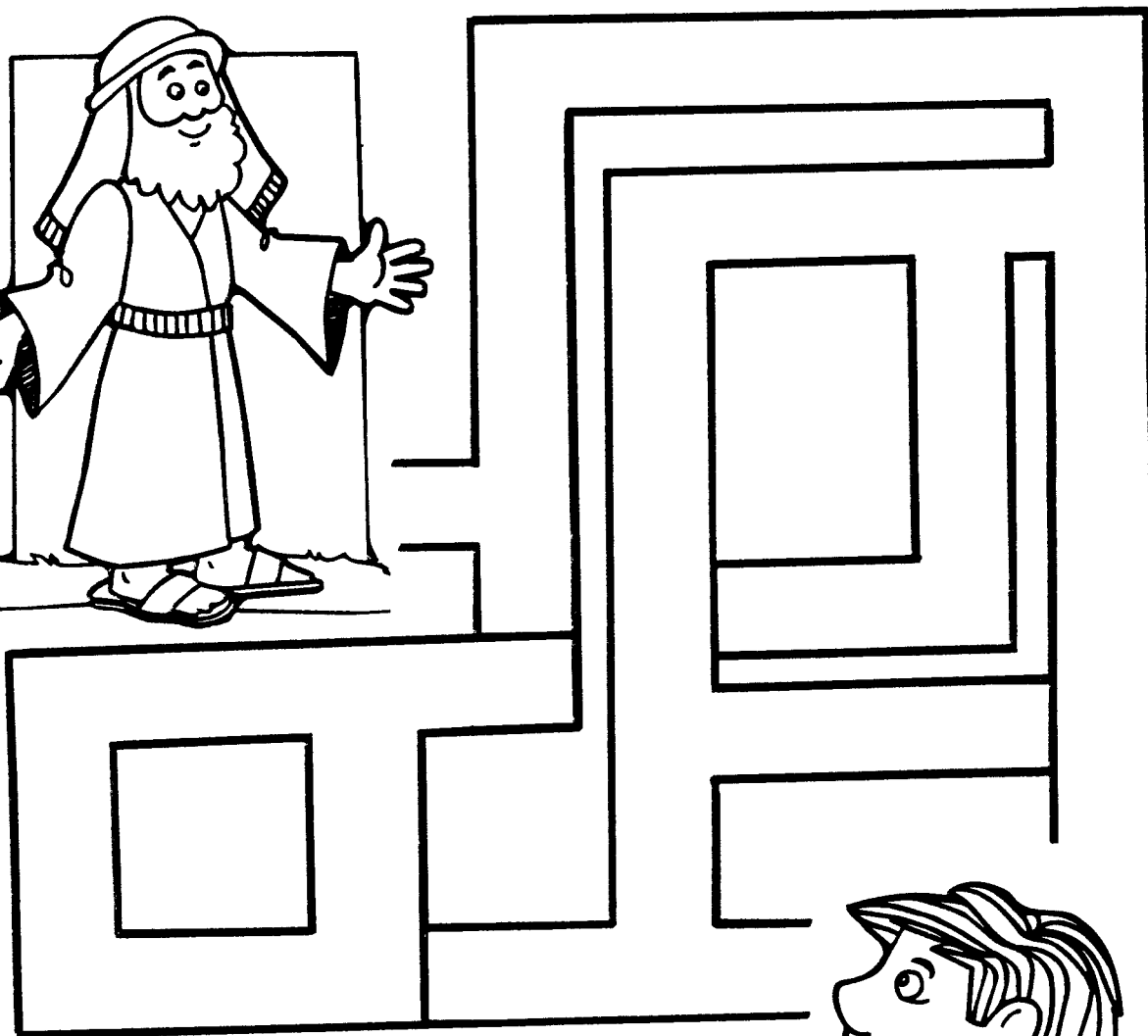
